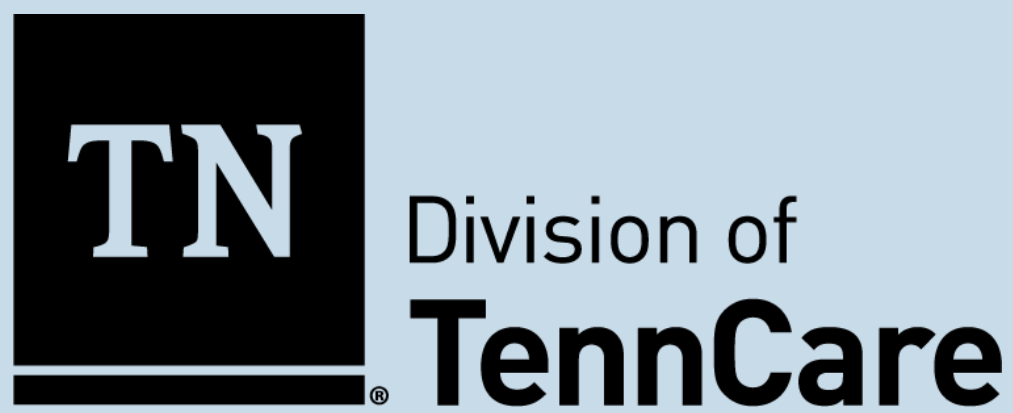
To access dental benefits, you must update your TennCare Connect account to tell us that you are pregnant. You can update your TennCare Connect account by phone or online.

# New Pregnancy Benefits

If you have TennCare Medicaid and you are pregnant you will now keep your health care for 12 months after delivery. You also have dental benefits during this time!

# It's time for you to visit the dentist!

If you have TennCare Medicaid coverage, dental benefits are available to you during your pregnancy and 12 months after delivery.

- A healthy mouth can mean better health for you and your baby now and in the future.
- There may be a link between gum disease and babies who are born too early or too small.
- It is important to see your dentist to get screened for gum disease. Routine and emergency dental care are safe during pregnancy.

## Don't forget to return for your postpartum visit!

If you are pregnant and have TennCare Medicaid, you will keep your coverage during your pregnancy and postpartum. This means you can keep getting health care and dental care for 12 months after you deliver.

- Be sure to talk to your doctor about your physical **and** mental health.
- If you have complications (for example high blood pressure or high blood sugar) in your pregnancy or after delivery, continue to see your doctor.
